### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

1. Draft Ordinance - An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance #08-21 Entitled, "An Ordinance To Amend and Replace In Its Entirety Chapter 34 of The Code of The Borough" – relative to Fast Food Restaurants – Zoning Official Mark Berninger to attend and discuss. Zoning Official Berninger addressed rumors that have been circulating regarding various fast food/chain restaurants coming into the Borough. He gave a brief history of fast food restaurants currently in town and encouraged the Council to consider forming a small committee to address this topic and discuss the benefits and concerns. The consensus was to table this topic until the work session for September 23<sup>rd</sup> giving the Zoning Official and the Borough Attorney time to collaborate on the definitions and wording.

- 2. **QPA Services Proposal The Canning Group LLC.** It was the consensus of the Council to continue using this company.
- 3. November 2021 Meeting Dates Change November 4, 2021 meeting to November 11, 2021 or have both two weeks in a row? It was decided to change the November meeting date to November 11, 2021.
- 4. November 2022 Meeting Dates Set the meeting date for November 3, 2022 or November 10, 2022 or have both two weeks in a row? It was decided to hold the 2022 November meeting on November 10.
- 5. Northwest Bergen Regional Health Commission Demographic Information presented to the Health Commission. Councilwoman Peet to discuss. The Health Commission is in the process of comparing the fifteen municipalities it serves to better tailor the types of assistance they offer.
